Adoption Day — Giving children love, homes

ST. JOHNS — Three Clinton County families have extra reasons to be thankful this Thanksgiving.

On Nov. 20 the families finalized the adoption of five children as part of Michigan Adoption Day. The event is one of more than 30 similar ceremonies taking place in Michigan. National Adoption Day is celebrated in all 50 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico. Last year more than 3,300 children from foster care were adopted as part of Adoption Day nationwide.

"This year all of the children (being adopted) have come through the foster care system in Clinton County," said Probate Judge Lisa Sullivan

Advertisement "I think this is significant because these are special children and the families have really opened their hearts and their homes to some special needs in a special way, so I really want to thank them."

Judge Sullivan said 6,200 children are in the foster care system in Michigan, and 4,200 of them are waiting for adoption.

"It is wonderful that we can see that permanency come to fruition today," she said.
