February 2023 Certified Passers

Please read the following carefully!

The results of the February 2023 bar examination were released to applicants on April 28, 2023. The results were mailed by United States Postal Service to the address registered with the Board of Law Examiners. **If you have moved and have not advised the Board's office of your new** *permanent* **address**, *you must* **update your address using the form on the BLE website. You may submit to the BLE via email,** *changes over the phone will not be accepted.* Applicants who do not have character and fitness clearance and/or who have not passed the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) and/or who have not notified the Board of their completion of the required Michigan Law Component, will receive unofficial results only and do <u>not</u> appear on this list. Applicants who have not been certified as having graduated from law school will not receive *any* results until that certification is received by the Board of Law Examiners and do not appear on this list.

DO NOT call or e-mail the Board of Law Examiners for results information. Results will not be released over the telephone or by e-mail and we will not give any information to family members, employers, or anyone else inquiring on an applicant's behalf.

Unsuccessful applicants should refer to their results letter for applicable forms, fees and deadlines for the July 2023 bar examination. Unsuccessful applicants who do not have character and fitness clearance within two years of law school graduation and/or who have not passed the MPRE are not eligible to retake the examination until character and fitness clearance **and** a passing MPRE score is received. Those applicants will not receive a re-examination form until eligibility is established. Unsuccessful applicants who graduated from law school within the past two years who still need character and fitness clearance should contact the Board's office to determine eligibility for re-examination.

DO NOT SCHEDULE ANY ADMISSION CEREMONY UNTIL YOU HAVE YOUR OFFICIAL RESULTS.

You must wait <u>15 business days</u> for the delivery of your results. If you have not received your results by May 10, 2023, you must submit a written request to the Board of Law Examiners to receive a duplicate results packet, emailed requests are accepted, <u>ble-info@courts.mi.gov</u>. Your request must include the following:

- A statement that you did not receive your original result packet,
- a statement promising to return your original result packet if received,
- your full name and current address.
