Public Satisfaction Survey Results


The public satisfaction measure provides a tool for surveying all court users about their experience in the courthouse by allowing court users to rate the court's accessibility and its treatment of the public in terms of fairness, equality, and respect. Comparison of results by locations, division, type of customer, and across courts can inform court management practices.

NOTES FOR 2022 DATA PACKET: The 2021 survey was conducted entirely online and resulted in fewer responses than prior years when the survey was conducted on paper. Courts that received 10 or more responses or 10% or more of the 2018 responses, will receive from SCAO a summary of their surveys in the 2022 data packet. To meet this threshold, your summary may include more courts or subsets of surveys than in prior years. For example, the results from circuit, probate, and district courts may be combined for one county.
