MCR 7.305(H)(1). The parties shall file supplemental briefs in accordance with MCR 7.312(E), addressing: (1) whether the appellee violated the appellants' Fourth Amendment rights by using an unmanned drone to take aerial photographs of the appellants' property for use in zoning and nuisance enforcement; and (2) whether the exclusionary rule applies to this dispute.
