- 1. Within 30 days after conviction for possessing or transporting liquor in a motor vehicle by a minor, a sworn complaint from a police officer requesting impoundment of the vehicle described below has been filed.
(Impoundment for not less than 15 nor more than 30 days at a public/private garage is at owner's expense and risk.)
- 2. The defendant has been convicted of driving on a suspended/revoked or denied license.
(Impoundment for not more than 120 days is with owner's implied consent, at owner's expense and risk.)
- 3. The described vehicle is alleged or found to be overweight.
(Vehicle must be moved by and at expense and risk of owner/driver to a place of safekeeping until the load is made legal and: [a] fine and costs are paid, [b] a bond is posted, double the amount of fine and costs, or [c] the court is satisfied that the fine and costs will be paid.)
