On order of the Court, the application for leave to appeal the May 14, 2025 judgment of the Court of Appeals is considered, and it is GRANTED. The time allowed for oral argument shall be 20 minutes for each side. MCR 7.314(B)(1). The parties shall include among the issues to be briefed: (1) whether *Cadillac Rubber & Plastics, Inc v Tubular Metal Sys, LLC*, 331 Mich App 416 (2020), remains good law after this Court's decision in *MSSC, Inc v Airboss Flexible Prods Co*, 511 Mich 176 (2023); and (2) whether a written contract for approximately 65-100% of a buyer's requirements satisfies the requirements of the Uniform Commercial Code's statute of frauds, MCL 440.2201(1).


