Comment:

Federal supremacy law supersedes state immigration law. Any interference through unenforceable state court rules/opinions that seek to interfere with Federal enforcement by using vague terms such as legal business or attending a court proceeding is protected only if the individual claiming this protection is a law abiding citizen not wanted for any outstanding warrants or federal immigration violations. The Michigan Supreme Court does not have the legal authority to overstep their state legal boundaries by creating non enforceable rules that by law remain in the Federal Supremacy Jurisdictional sphere.
