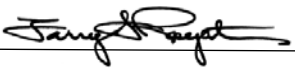
The appellants shall file a supplemental brief addressing whether the Office of Retirement Services has the authority under the Michigan Public School Employees Retirement Act, MCL 38.1301 *et seq.*, to create and implement normal salary increase schedules. See MCL 38.1303a(3)(f); MCL 38.1303a(5). The appellants' brief shall be filed by March 28, 2022, with no extensions except upon a showing of good cause. In the brief, citations to the record must provide the appendix page numbers as required by MCR 7.312(B)(1). The appellees shall file a supplemental brief within 21 days of being served with the appellants' brief. A reply, if any, must be filed by the appellants within 14 days of being served with the appellees' brief. The parties should not submit mere restatements of their application papers.
