By order dated September 16, 2021, in the case *Davis v Independent Citizens Redistricting Commission*, Docket No. 163486, the Court announced that it would issue “emergency rules forthwith establishing the procedural requirements for original actions filed under Const 1963, art 4, §6(19).” By order of the Court, until those emergency rules are issued, the Court will issue orders in all cases in which an action is brought by or against the Independent Citizens Redistricting Commission advising the parties of all necessary deadlines and requirements to be followed in the matter. This order is intended to allow maximum flexibility in the short term to address the potential need for the parties to act under truncated time frames and possibly nonuniform periods.

This order will remain in effect until any emergency rules are issued by this Court.
